

ORIGIN SOLAR FLEX AGREEMENT SUMMARY AND NEXT STEPS

Agreement summary

Here is a summary of the key features of the Origin Solar Flex – *Generation Power Purchase Agreement (Agreement)*. Before you sign the Agreement, it is important that you understand these features. You should also read the Agreement.

- **Nature of this Agreement:** This is a long term agreement with potentially significant financial implications for you. Whether and how you benefit (including any financial benefit) from this agreement depends on your particular circumstances, including your daily consumption levels and patterns.
- **Monitoring your consumption:** You understand the importance of monitoring and matching your daytime consumption to the solar electricity generation in order to maximise the benefits of this Agreement.
- **You are buying solar electricity:** You pay us for all solar electricity generated by our solar system at the contract rate, regardless of whether you use the solar electricity or not. The contract rate, and whether it is adjusted for CPI annually or fixed for the term of the Agreement, is set out in Schedule 1.
- **You are not buying a solar system:** Origin will own the solar system.
- **Feed in tariffs:** You may be eligible for a feed in tariff for solar electricity you do not use, but you will need to confirm this with your electricity retailer.
- **Monthly email bills:** We will email you your bill monthly for the electricity generated by our solar system.
- **Other fees may apply:** Other fees that may apply include:
 - in certain circumstances where you end this Agreement before the installation of our Solar System, a site inspection cancellation fee and a post-approval cancellation;
 - a late payment fee if you pay your bill late;
 - a reactivation fee if we have to reactivate our solar system following deactivation caused by

- your conduct; and
- a removal fee for us to remove the system at the end of the Agreement Term.
- **You can end this Agreement early:** If you want to end the Agreement or move property, you have a number of options including:
 - pay us an exit fee
 - make us an offer to buy our solar system, or
 - arrange for the new owner/tenant of the property to take up the service (provided that they meet our credit requirements and enter into an agreement with us).
- **Origin can end this Agreement early:** We may end the Agreement in a range of circumstances including if you repeatedly don't pay your monthly bills, if the output of our solar system is significantly reduced or we think that this Agreement is no longer commercially viable for us.

Next Steps

1. We will conduct a credit check of your business.
2. We will conduct a site inspection. If we determine that your site is not suitable for the installation, or additional works are required other than the Inclusions or Exclusions set out in Schedule 1, then we may end this Agreement (with no exit fee payable by you).
3. We will initiate the approvals listed in the Inclusions (see Schedule 1).
4. We will be in touch to coordinate and assist you obtain any third party consents you must obtain in order for the installation to go ahead.
5. Once the above steps are complete, we will arrange installation at a time that is suitable to both you and our contractor.
6. Your existing electricity meter may need to be upgraded or changed before we can activate the solar system. Your distributor will usually arrange for this to occur and invoice you directly. You should pay this invoice and Origin will reimburse you if this is listed in the Inclusions (see Schedule 1).
